# Two-Digit Quotients

Divide. Estimate to make sure your answer is reasonable.

$$23 \overline{)488}$$

There are not enough hundreds, so divide by tens.

$$\begin{array}{r} 21 \text{ R}5 \\ 23 \overline{)488} \\ \underline{-46} \phantom{0} \\ 28 \\ \underline{-23} \\ 5 \end{array}$$

Check:

$$\begin{array}{r} 23 \\ \times 21 \\ \hline +460 \\ 483 \\ + 5 \\ \hline 488 \end{array}$$

$$488 \div 23 = 21 \text{ R}5$$

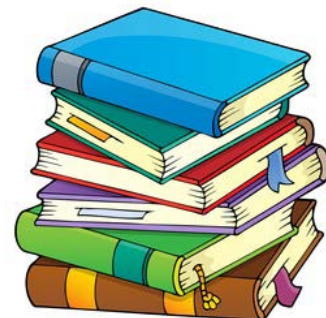
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## Problem Solving
